Friends of the Fenway Garden Society was organized to encourage the whole community to get involved with helping to preserve the park and continue the tradition of the historic Victory Gardens.

The Fenway Garden Society is a non-profit organization that oversees the Victory Gardens within the Back Bay Fens, a 7-acre Boston city park that is part of the historic Emerald Necklace.

The Garden Society not only oversees the garden plots and gardeners with an all volunteer staff, but maintains the irrigation system, manages an urban forestry program, manages the compost, keeps up much of the park's infrastructure including fencing and pathways, special needs garden, and participates in community building like working with the Green Team, Simmons College, and partnerships with Fenway High School's SLUG program - just to name a few.
